



RFP Questions

1. There should be more pages on technical (not subject matter): Answer - A revised RFP was sent out on October 23, 2019 that designated additional pages to Section C.
2. What is the ideal schedule on a draft report: Answer – Participating agencies are hopeful to have a draft by July 2020.
3. Attachment B is missing: Answer - Corrected in the revised RFP.
4. Are you open to additional suggestions: Answer - The revised RFP now indicates "Provide any further suggestions to make this study a success."
5. Is Orangevale/Fair Oaks still willing to participate in regards to contacting them for information. If additional findings arise to benefit Orangevale/Fair Oaks, would they be open to alternatives: Answer – Orange Vale Water Company and Fair Oaks Water District has chosen to not participate in the Study.
6. Is there any pressure from regulatory agencies, such as LAFCo, to move toward a consolidation: Answer – No. Participation in this Study is 100% voluntary.
7. We are preparing a response to the RFP for Collaboration/Integration Study. The RFP asks for the following: Provide a summary of all past projects involving any Agency. This summary shall include:
 - a. Name of public agency
 - b. Name and title of contact person.
 - c. Telephone number of contact person.
 - d. Brief description of the project including start and completion dates and your firm's role in the project.
 - e. The telephone number and contact names of private firms involved in the project.

To avoid a conflict of interest, if your firm, is/has provided professional services to any of the Agencies please list the name of the agency and services provided.

What is meant by "any Agency"? If you mean any public agency, our list of public agency clients is several hundred. Listing them all, along with descriptions of hundreds of projects, would be very long. Answer: "any Agency" are only the agencies listed in the subject RFP.
